
VIRTUAL RESPIRATORY CARE & EDUCATION CONFERENCE

We are particularly interested in sessions that will showcase excellence and innovation in the critical thinking & application skills needed for today's respiratory and tobacco educators.

Virtual Education Session Expectations

- Education sessions and workshops will be 60 minutes in length and are expected to be as interactive as possible (e.g. case studies, polls, Q&A, facilitated small group discussions etc.)
- Active experiential approaches to learning models should be promoted and be based on principles of adult learning & professional development (the sorts of learning experiences that can achieve a wide range of knowledge, skill, values & participation objectives).
- Lecture style input should be kept to a minimum and is always referred to as a "minilecture". (Allow 60% of the time for participant interaction.)
- The content of the education session/workshop should meet the learning needs of the participants (novice to experts).
- A variety of learning experiences should be used based upon principles of adult learning & professional development.
