Getting There

We realize that it will require a little more effort to get to Niagara Falls but we're sure that when you arrive, you will realize that it was well worth it. There is a reason why 13 million visitors a year make Niagara Falls a top "bucket list" destination.

There are three international airports within an hour's drive by car to the Sheraton on the Falls Hotel. We do recommend that you fly into Pearson's however, as that is where we have arranged the discounted shuttle to Niagara Falls.

Distance to Niagara Falls:

- Buffalo Niagara International Airport - 43 km
- John C. Munro Hamilton International Airport - 85 km
- Toronto Pearson International Airport - 125 km

Shuttle from Airports

We have arranged for a discounted shuttle from Pearson Airport with Niagara Air Bus. The cost is \$82+GST return. Call (905) 329-8111 or go to www.niagaraairbus.com/

You must put in code 302 to receive the discount. Prices will be automatically discounted.

Niagara Air Bus will offer CNRC delegates a 10% discount on private limos from all other airports (but this option is still priced).

If you are flying into the Toronto Island Airport (Billy Bishop), take the free shuttle to Union Station. From there you can take a VIA train or GO bus to Niagara Falls.
