The Canadian Network for Respiratory Care (CNRC, through its certified educators and member organizations, works to improve the quality of life for Canadians and their families living with respiratory diseases, and tobacco use disorder by developing, promoting and advocating the highest standards of education in health promotion and care.

CNRC offers a national certification program for respiratory educators - the Certified Asthma Educator (CAE) and Certified Respiratory Educator (CRE). CNRC provides the Certified Tobacco Educator (CTE) credential for healthcare professionals who provide tobacco prevention and cessation services to their clients. CNRC also offers the Certified COPD Educator (CCE) credential for US healthcare professionals working with clients who have COPD.

CNRC's National Respiratory Care and Education Conference is held every two years. Content focuses on health promotion, patient education, and respiratory care – particularly asthma, COPD, allergy, pulmonary rehabilitation, tobacco prevention & cessation, lung cancer, other lung diseases (including IPF and Alpha-1 Antitrypsin Deficiency) and relevant co-morbidities. Content also focuses on the importance of vaccine education, smoking cessation, and access to relevant diagnostic testing and appropriate management. Delegates reflect the multidisciplinary nature of the respiratory management and tobacco education teams, including: respiratory therapists, nurses, pharmacists, specialist physicians and physiotherapists.

CNRC respiratory and tobacco educators are on the frontlines of patient care, working in a wide variety of healthcare settings, from hospital-based respiratory education clinics to family health teams to school-based asthma education programs to community pharmacies. Geographically, they are located all over Canada, from the Yukon to PEI. CNRC educators increasingly work in primary care with family physicians who regard them as respiratory care experts. We expect to have between 300 and 350 delegates in Calgary.

# LIABILITY AND INSURANCE


